

St. Mark's is in the process of kicking off a Food Pantry ministry in the near future. Plans are to use the small kitchen. If you have anything






Sign Up For a Lenten Study



- This is for both Middle School and High School students!
- March 18-21 the youth are leading a Bible Club for local kids (this includes St. Mark's kids). The Bible Club will be from 12:30-2:30 and the youth and leaders will need to be there from 12-3.
- March 22-23 we'll be celebrating on a trip to Six Flags over Texas! We're leaving early Friday morning and we'll be back midday on Saturday.
- Students must participate in each day of the mission in order to go to Six Flags. Guests are the exception. They can go to Six Flags without having participated in the mission.
