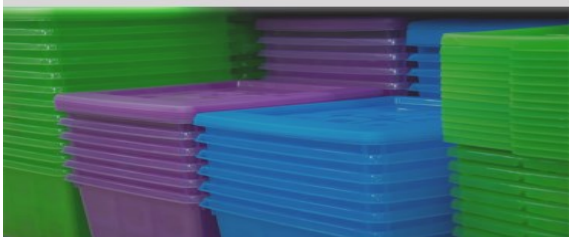

You may take your lilies home after services on Easter Sunday.

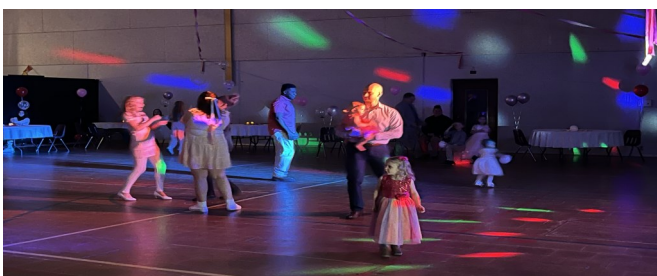
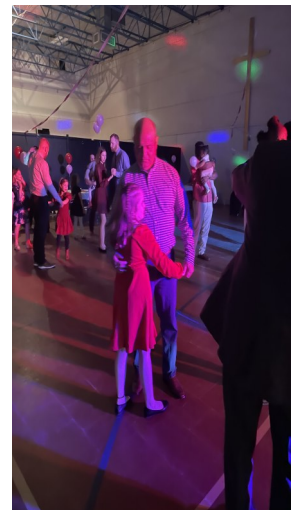

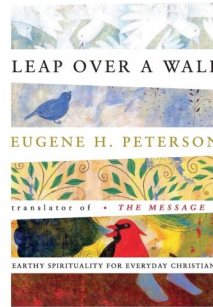


St Mark's Bethany Helping Hand Project
