



# Mexico Mission Trip



Please pray for the members of the church going on our Mexico City Mission Trip -- Steve Couch, Mike Kilby, Brian Ray, Elijah Coats, Josh Coats and Bequer Gomez.

They'll be serving with our long term missionary partners Troy and Jenny Gentry in Mexico City. St. Mark's just raised funds for one of their facilities' roof, one of their main outreach programs called MEFI, through the Christmas offering.

MEFI is a ministry reaching out to Mexico City's homeless children and young people. Proyecto MEFI (Mercy, Esperanza (hope), Faith, and Integration) plays off the name "Mephibosheth" from 2nd Samuel 9. MEFI is a ministry aimed at saving street children from a life of drugs, prostitution, and abuse.

The vision is to equip and train the local churches of Mexico to unite and lead society in the eradication of homelessness among children and young people.

Please pray for safe travels and that God prepares their hearts for what He has in store for them.
