Please join us in praying for the families that come on Sunday evenings. Pray our team that we can love these families well and be there for them however it is needed.




Fall Fun with Friends!



For our budget with TMS Global (which includes our personal income, ministry expenses, health insurance, admin fees, etc), we are supposed to have 100% of the recurring pledges coming in on a regular bases and have 2 months of the monthly support in the account at all times in case of emergency. Including the equivalent to monthly support for our current quarterly and annual partners, we are averaging around 90% of our budget each month coming in and we are currently maintaining around 70% of our 2 months of account balance.
