

A reminder to those who bought tickets for the December 20th Symphony performance in Yukon- we will leave the church at 6:45.








SUNDAY MORNING:

Children are encouraged to come and participate in a children's sermon time, and following that, are welcome to sit with their parents or guardians for the remainder of the worship service time, or they are welcome to go back to children's area with Ms. Alicia.

11:15 - Noon - we will focus again on the lesson God is teaching us through the Bible story that was taught in the first hour. 
