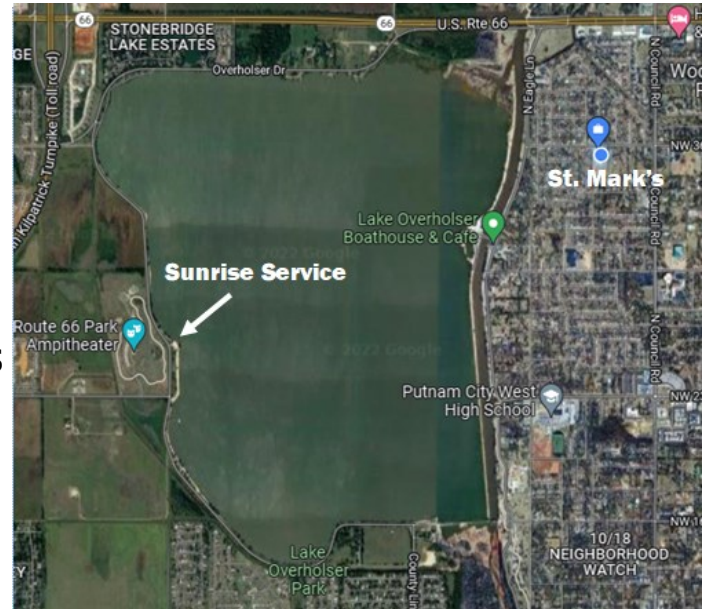


### **Easter Sunday Worship at St. Mark's, April 17, 2022**
